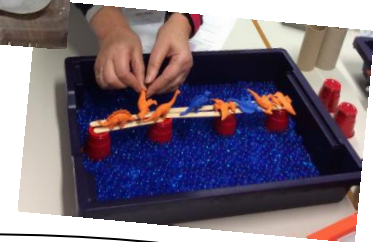
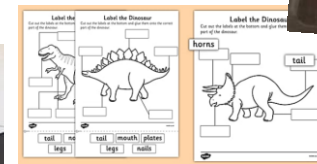
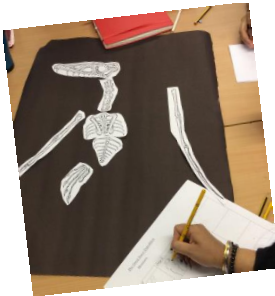
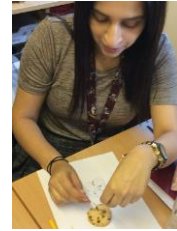
## Sandfield's Science CPD on **DINOSAURS**

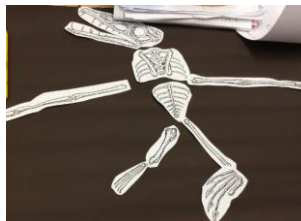
Science with a cookie – **observation** for identification, and extracting the chocolate chip for fine motor skills and trying to appreciate the work that fossil hunters do.
