### Geography

We will learn about the world's continents, oceans, and identify some of the UK's most famous landmarks and some amazing places around the world. We will identify key physical features and human features. We will carry out fieldwork by investigating local habitats.

### History

### Design and Technology


### PE

### Science

We will learn about the properties and uses of everyday materials. We will develop important scientific skills by asking questions, researching, and conducting investigations. We will explore different materials and discover why certain materials are used for specific purposes. We will carry out experiments to observe and describe the characteristics of these materials.



### Music

Our 'Myths and Legends' unit will help us explore the structure of music, focusing on rhythm, melody, and dynamics. We will compose our own music with multiple layers, creating pieces that tell a story. We will develop our listening, creativity, and teamwork skills as we bring our compositions to life.



### Religious Education
