



Topic

History Explorers

We will become Historians and we will continue to explore the past through learning about the lives of Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong and begin to understand where they are on a timeline. We will be developing our history skills by looking at sources including photographs to ask and answer questions.

Geography

In Geography this term, we will explore the question, "What is it like to live by the coast?" We will learn about coastal environments, the features of the coast, and how people live and work in coastal areas.

Design and Technology

We will research foods and wraps before we design, make and evaluate our own healthy nutritional wrap. Finally, we will make mechanisms by creating a moving monster.

Art

We will create pinch pots and design and make clay tiles with features of a house. We will be developing practical skills in working with clay and applying artistic techniques through a structured project.

Computing

We will be developing an understanding of programming using Scratch Junior by learning the sequences of commands have an outcome. Finally, we will create our own quiz.



PSHE/RSE

The relationships unit will help us understand that everyone's family is different. It also looks at our friendships and how to deal with conflict and identifying people we trust. Changing me helps us recognise how we change from young to old and recognise how my body changes.



PE


We will be developing our attacking, defending and shooting skills helping us understand strategies and improve our cooperation, coordination and confidence. We will develop our ability to hit, catch and run and understand the importance of team work.



Science

In science we will build up scientific skills, asking questions, researching and carrying out investigations. This term we will be developing these skills as we learn about plants. We will be identifying, observing and describing how seeds and bulbs grow into plants and what plants need to grow and stay healthy.

We will also learn about pushes and pulls within forces and movements.



Music

In the *Musical Me* unit, we will explore music by using our voices and bodies to make sounds. We will also further develop our basic music skills like rhythm, melody and dynamics, and have fun creating and performing music.



Religious Education

We will learn about how Hindus and Christians celebrate their life journeys. Including the celebration of birth, the significance of actions and symbols and the idea of belonging.
